The Ceremony was dedicated to paying tribute to our dear friend and founding father of the programme and EIUC, **Antonio Papisca**, who sadly passed away in mid-May this year. Among the guest speakers **Stavros Lambrinidis**, EU Special Representative for Human Rights, and former member of the European Parliament. The Ceremony was accompanied by the ensemble **Musicians for Human Rights**.
