EIUC Diplomatic Conference "Human Rights of Migrants and Refugees: Challenges for EU External Action"

The European Inter-University Centre for Human Rights and Democratisation ([EIUC](#)) will host at its premises, the Monastery of San Nicolò - Venice Lido, on 2 July, the 2016 edition of the **EIUC Diplomatic Conference**, dedicated to **Human Rights of Migrants and Refugees: Challenges for EU External Action**. The Conference will be opened by Prof. Manfred Nowak, EIUC Secretary-General, Zdzislaw Kedzia, EIUC President, and Ciara O'Brian, Chair of the European Union's Working Party on Human Rights (COHOM).
