Abstract

The 2024 Global Classroom is an International Student Conference and one of our flagship research and networking programs for students and professors. It is hosted by the latest addition to the Global Campus, the Master Programme for Human Rights and Sustainability in Central Asia (MAHRS) at the OSCE Academy in Bishkek in Kyrgyzstan, from 17-21 June 2024 and will take place at a lake resort at Issyk Kul.

This year's Global Student Conference on 'Just Transition: Conditions for Change of the Global Order' presents student papers and research projects from worldwide regional perspectives. Students elaborate on how civil society engagement, democratic institution building, International Human Rights, and Criminal Law can or could frame societal change and political transition pathways in the current search for a new global order. How resilient are democratic institutions toward the dramatic backsliding of democratic practices? And can the pathways of transitology and transitional justice in times of war and conflict in the different regions of the world progress?

Students from the 8 Global Campus regional Master's Programmes join the conference from Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean, Europe, South East Europe, the Caucasus, the MENA and Arab world, Asia Pacific, and Central Asia.
