## Press Release of GC Caucasus (CES - Yerevan State University) on the Opening of the Hybrid International Conference 2021



On the 10th of May 2021, the opening of the Hybrid Global Campus International Conference on **“Climate change and Children: Impact, Rights and participation”** will take place at 14:00 at the Centre for European Studies of the Yerevan State University. The event is organised within the frames of the Regional Master’s Programme in Human Rights and Democratisation in the Caucasus programme GC Caucasus.

The aim of the conference is to bring together experts, representatives of States, international and non-governmental organisations, policymakers to discuss the impact of the climate change on the next generation through presentations, panel discussions and keynote speeches.
