## **18-22 January 2010: Training of Trainers on "Legal aspects of enforced disappearances"**

A **Memorandum of Understanding** between **EIUC** and [Aim for Human Rights](#) was signed on 1st December 2009 for the organisation of training activities on the subject of **Legal Protection from Enforced Disappearances**. A Training of Trainers on "Legal aspects of enforced disappearances" took place from **18 to 22 January 2010** at the EIUC premises, the Monastery of San Nicolò in Venice-Lido (Italy).

A special programme on Human Rights Defenders

was held for E.MA students on 21 January 2010.

### ***Objective of the training:***

To prepare a pool of trainers from all over the world who are willing and able to train others on legal protection from enforced disappearances.

### ***Specific objectives:***

1. Further enhancement of knowledge regarding legal aspects of enforced disappearances;
2. Development of various training skills;
3. Motivate participants to give trainings on the subject themselves.
