Inauguration of the first Master in Democratic Governance Democracy and Human Rights

On Monday, 9 February 2015, the <u>Master in Democratic Governance (DE.MA)</u> - Democracy and Human Rights in the MENA Region (DE.MA), the first master's programme specialised in the field of democratic governance and human rights with a focus on the Arab world, was officially opened at the European Inter-University Centre for Human Rights and Democratisation.
