Prof. Kedzia elected to the Committee on Social, Economic and Cultural Rights



Professor Zdzislaw (Dzidek) Kedzia from Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan (Poland) has recently been **elected to the Committee on Social, Economic and Cultural Rights for the term 2009 – 2012.**

Professor Kedzia is the Polish national director of E.MA.

He teaches international human rights law and constitutional law.

His professional experience includes, in addition to academic career, diplomatic service (1990 – 1994) and the work in the UN Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (1994 – 2005) where he recently was the Chief of the Research and Right to Development Branch.
